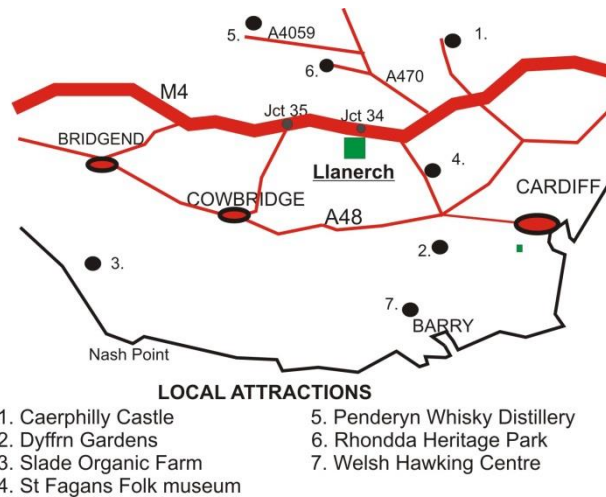

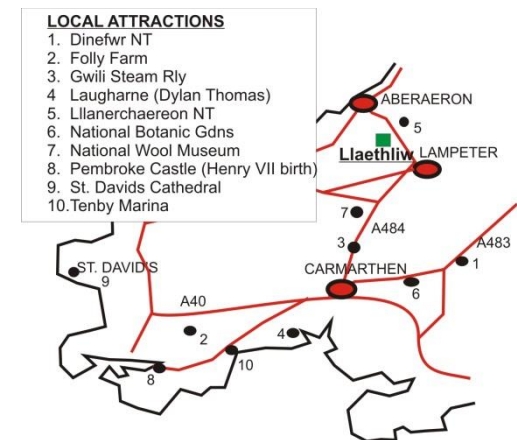

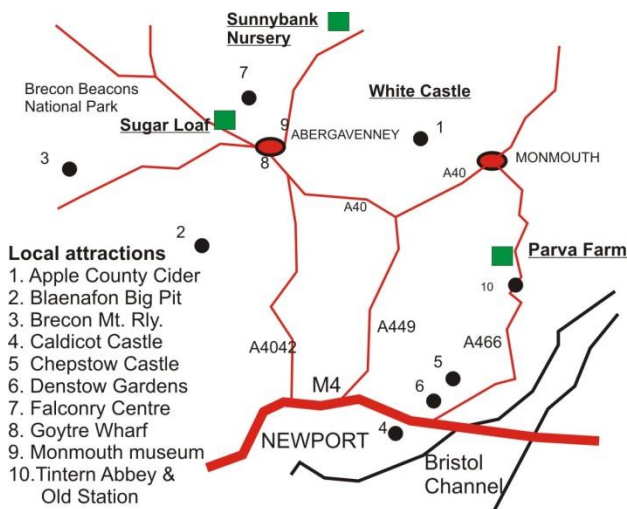

Take a day out- visit a vineyard

Do you fancy a day out, an ancient castle, a steam train and to finish, a wine tasting in a first class restaurant before retiring for the night in your self-catering cottage. There is nowhere better than in Wales.

Vineyards have been part of the scenery of Wales probably since Roman times. They all but died out after the dissolution of the monasteries, but were re-introduced by the Marquis of Bute at Castell Coch in 1873. Though sugar rationing in WW1 brought the enterprise to an end, it has been revived with great success. Now there are over 20 vineyards across Wales, producing award-winning wines. Many of the vineyards have shops, restaurants and visitor centres- and can form a perfect part of your day out and taste nationally acclaimed wines.

What wines will you find?



Wines are produced to meet every taste. Each vineyard produces a different style of wine because of its unique micro-climate. Many produce a red wine from the Rondo grape- a light, fruity wine that can be drunk by itself or with Welsh lamb or cawl. The white wines are from a variety of grapes. Solaris produces a perfumed fruity wine.

Many vineyards also produce 'Pefriog', Welsh sparkling wine made from a variety of grapes including Seyval Blanc and the traditional Pinot Noir. This is sold aged or as a young, refreshing wine ideal for a summer afternoon in the garden.

White Castle vineyard has released a fortified Port-style wine, the first ever to be released in Wales. Ideal with a mature Caerphilly cheese.
