Vineyards have been part of the scenery of Wales probably since Roman times. They all but died out after the dissolution of the monasteries, but were re-introduced by the Marquis of Bute at Castell Coch in 1873. Though sugar rationing in WW1 brought the enterprise to an end, it has been revived, firstly by the Norris family at Glyndwr in 1973. Now there are over 20 vineyards across Wales, producing award-winning wines Many of the vineyards have shops, restaurants and visitor centres- and can form a perfect part of your day out.
